The Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, as the authority competent to make admission in Master's Programme in Pharmacy (M.Pharma) course on the basis of **Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test-2011 (GPAT-2011)** conducted by The M.S. University of Baroda, Vadodra. On the basis of this test the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar shall conduct counseling for the Institutions located in the State of Punjab for the session 2011-12. The admission shall be made in the following Institutions:-

The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to issue the following criteria for admission thereafter: -

(A) **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :-**

All those candidate who have passed B Pharma with atleast 55% marks in aggregate, preferably with valid GPAT -2011 score shall be eligible.

(B) **GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION :-**

- i. 85% seats will be reserved for the candidates from within the state and 15% will be open to all candidates from outside the State which of course will be inter-convertible in case the seats remain vacant in internal or outside category.
- ii. Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria shall be as contained in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab Memo No. 35/44/95-1T(2)/978 dated 21st March, 2003, which is annexed to this notification. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.

Exemption under above Para

Children/wards/dependent (whose parent are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Service borne on Punjab cadre, Serving judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards/ Corporations/Statutory Bodies established by an act of the state of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before 1st January of the year of entrance test that is on or before 1st January, 2010 and their children/wards/ dependents may have done 10+1 and/or 10+2 outside Punjab.

- iii. Admission of candidates, who fulfill all other conditions for admission, shall be effected on the basis of the inter-se merit of qualifying examination subject to reservation of seats. The detailed instructions in respect of which are given hereinafter.

(C) **RESERVATION :**

- (i) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training **Memo. No. 13 / 2/ 05 -1TE2/409** dated 20th February 2006,, which is annexed to this notification. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication
- (ii) The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced on the date of Counselling shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of Counselling, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. Candidates are required to claim reservation in the application form. If no reservation is claimed the candidates shall be treated and considered as a "General Candidate".

- (iii) The PTU shall make a provision in the application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which they are seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any, under which reservation is being sought, so that *inter se* gradation can be facilitated. These sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo No. 13 / 2/ 05 -1TE2/409 dated 20th February 2006, which is annexed to this notification. Punjab Government may also set up a committee to effect *inter se* gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 20th February 2006
- (iv) A candidate shall be eligible to make claim for reservation under any number of appropriate reserved categories. However, the procedure for counselling shall be as per Punjab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) Memo. No. 7/21/2004 - RS1 / 1674 - 1677 dated 20th Dec., 2004,

(D) **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

- i) The student shall be liable to pay fee/Development fee and other charges as fixed by the Govt. of Punjab/AICTE/Concerned University from time to time.
- ii) The management quota shall be as per Punjab Govt. Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1247 dated 25th April 2008, Partial Notification no 13/129/2003-1TE2/1892 dated 20th June 2008 and Partial Notification no 13/129/2003-1TE2/171 dated 18th January, 2011 which are annexed to this notification.
- iii) Admission to the M.Pharma course, both for 85% seats for Resident of Punjab and 15% seats for outsiders, shall be made strictly on the basis of Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test-2011 (GPAT-2011) and in case seats not being filled under respective category vice versa eligibility may be considered.
- iv) **Counselling for 85% seats for Punjab residents shall be taken up first followed by counselling for 15% seats for outside Punjab candidates. Counselling for 85% General Category will be held first followed by counselling for reserved category.**

Counselling for 15% seats for general category will be held first followed by counselling for reserve category. For 15% category, seats remaining vacant in 85% quota will be transferred to 15% quota in the respective category, as applicable. Seats still remaining unfilled under respective reserve categories and general category even after the end of counselling shall be transferred to management quota seats under the respective reserve categories and general category.

The college / university will make a public notice to this effect indicating clearly the no. of seats vacant in each reserve category and general category and fill the seats in that very particular category only. After exhausting the above said procedure, if still the seats remain vacant in reserve category the college / university can fill it from candidates belonging to general category. Admission to such unfilled/vacant seats

as well as management quota shall be furnished and finalized within 15 days of the last date of counselling.

- v) 85% seats would be reserved for the candidates from within the state of Punjab and 15% will be open to all candidates from outside the State. The eligibility criteria for 85% seats will be that the candidates should be a resident of Punjab State in terms of Punjab Govt., Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP II Branch) letter no. 1/3/95-3PP II/9619 dated 6th June 1996 and letter no. 1/3/95-3PP II / 81 dated 1st Jan 1999. **However Children of Defence Personnel posted in Punjab are exempted from this condition to the extent that they should have passed only qualifying examination from a recognized Institution situated in Punjab.** Each candidate would be required to submit a certificate to this effect from the Principal / Head of Institution last attended in the prescribed Performa.
- vi) Any seat falling vacant after counselling or any drop out vacancy will be filled by the institute on the criteria of admission under management quota. A seat once accepted shall not be changed.
- vii) The information about the eligibility for admission to M.Pharma also about the institution/discipline/ category-wise availability of seats and reservation of seats for various categories shall be made available by Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar on website www.ptuadmissions.nic.in.
- viii) If any new Institution is approved or seats are increased/alterd in the existing institutions. by the AICTE and such approval is received before the commencement of the counselling, PTU shall cause a public notice of the same to be published, invite additional preference from the candidates, at the till end of their original choices, without, however, altering the previous choice. These new institutes as well as addition / alternation in seats shall be taken into consideration and admission shall be effected accordingly. However, any such approval etc. received after the above mentioned time shall not be taken into consideration and no admission to such institutes shall be made for the academic session 2011-12.
- ix) The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/PIO shall be the same as was in vogue for NRI candidates.
- x) The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals/PIO shall be as per **Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-ITE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23rd January, 2002.**
- xi) The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per **Punjab Government Notification No. 35/44/95-ITE2/3244 dated Chandigarh the 30th August 2001.**
- xii) Non refundable counseling fee of Rs. 3000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) will be collected by the University as counseling fee from each student one time only.
